Housing Options

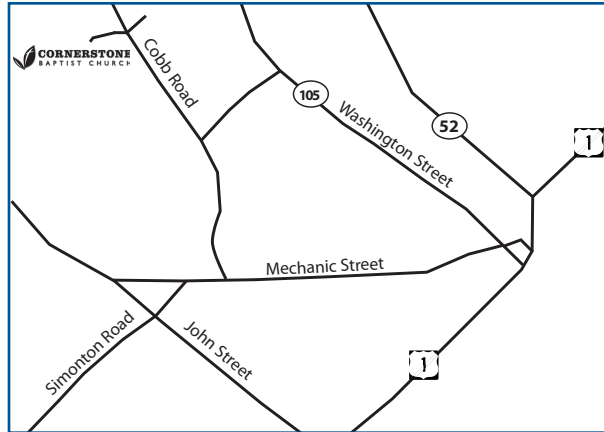
- ❖ Host families would love to have you stay in their homes! (space is limited so first come, first served)

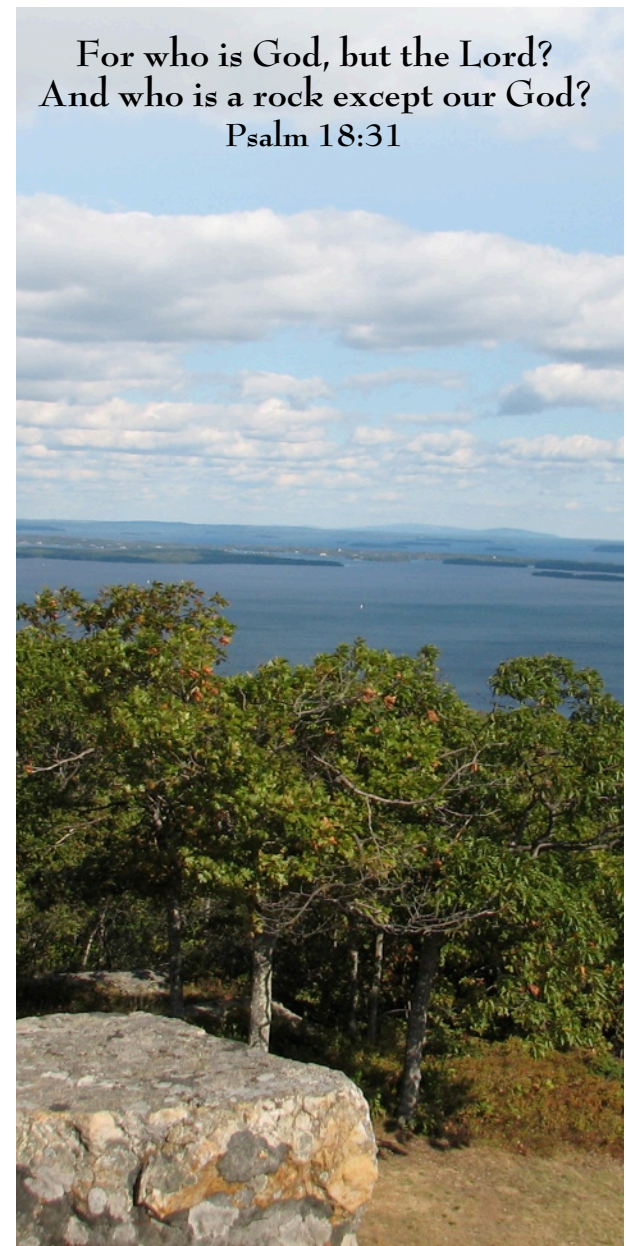

Cathy Wilcox

Cathy was born in Caribou, Maine. Her family moved to Pennsylvania where they became involved in the ministries of Independent Baptist Church in Towanda. She attended Baptist Bible College of PA where she pursued a BS in Bible and a nursing degree. Cathy was living in Alaska when she left to travel with the revival ministry, “Life Action Ministries,” and was involved in children’s work. An outreach trip to the Philippines confirmed God’s call to missions. Cathy married Bob Wilcox in 1988. In 1989 they became missionaries with ABWE (Association of Baptists for World Evangelism) to be church planters in Gambia, West Africa. Bob and Cathy ministered in Africa from 1992-96. God opened an opportunity in 1999 to minister in Maine in a church strengthening ministry at Cornerstone Baptist Church in North Jay. That work became self-supporting in 2010. Although Bob and Cathy left ABWE in 2008, they remain active in the work. Along the way, the Lord blessed them with four boys. She has worked as an ED Tech in a public school and currently is employed as a registered nurse. She and her family reside in Livermore Falls, ME.

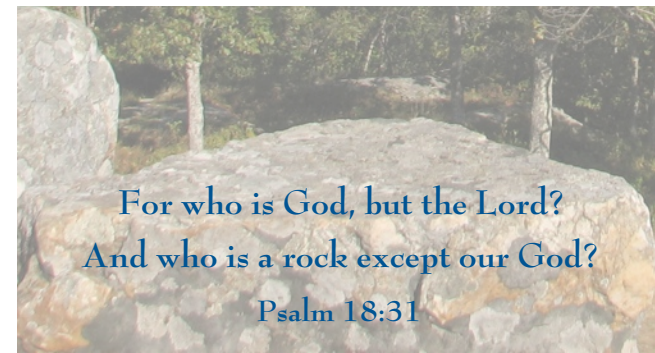
