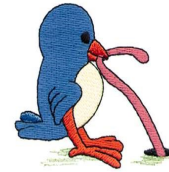

Nursery Facilities

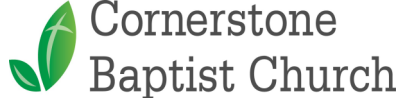
Our nursery room is available to nursing mothers & their babies. Older children, however, should enjoy the opportunity to spend some quality time with Dad and/or Grandpa.

Directions

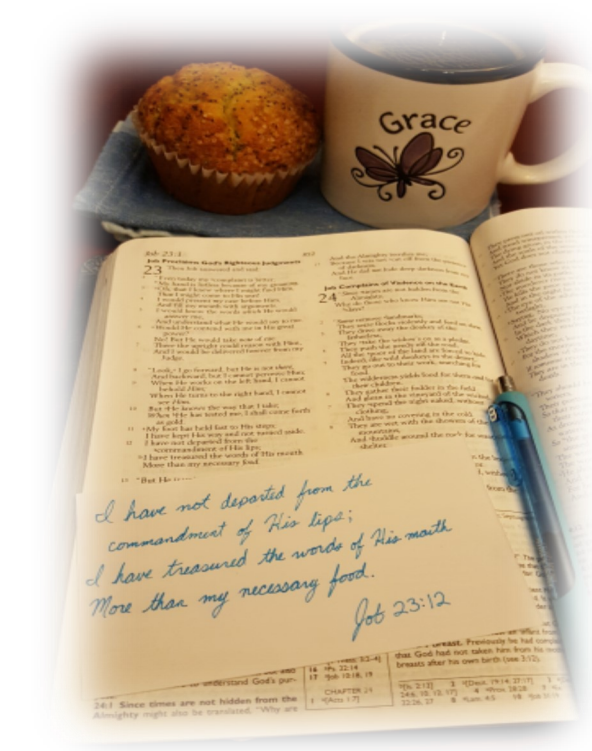
